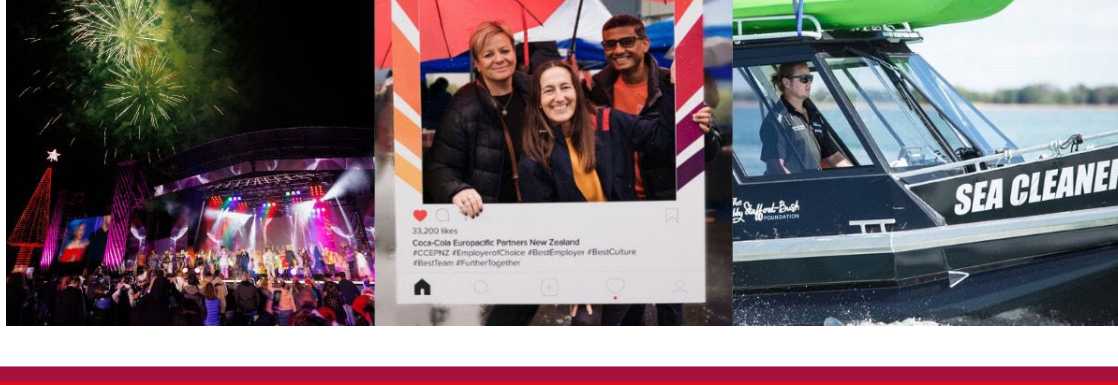

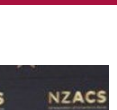

Using 100% Certified Renewable Electricity

We have an ambition to reach net zero reported emissions by 2040 and have taken a major step forward to meet this commitment by adopting Meridian Energy's [100% Certified Renewable Energy](#) product.

We're now able to report our market-based Scope Two electricity emissions as zero*.

Since 1 April 2021, 100% of CCEP NZ's electricity use is certified under the [New Zealand Energy Certificate System \(NZECS\)](#).

We support a Container Deposit Scheme in NZ

Earlier this year, the government announced three proposals to transform recycling in New Zealand which includes a container deposit scheme consultation to return empty beverage containers for recycling.

We support the establishment of a container return scheme that is well run, industry led and not for profit. Overall, we welcome the Ministry's announcement and are pleased to see many of our suggestions to maximise collection of a container return scheme.

Bottles made from 100% Recycled Plastic

In 2019, CCEP NZ made the commitment to significantly increase our investment in recycled plastic.

Since then all our plastic bottles under 1 litre and water bottles across all sizes are made with 100% recycled plastic (excluding caps and labels).
